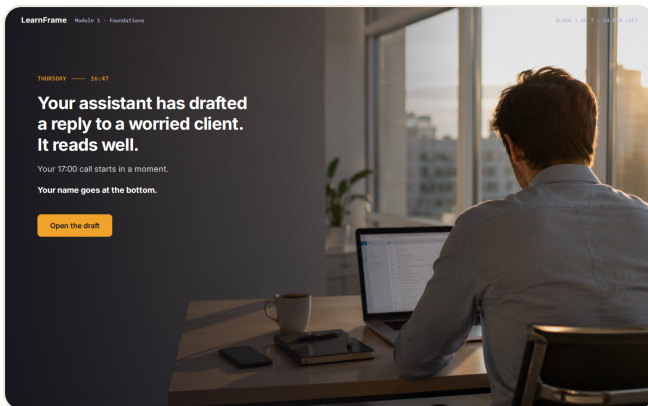

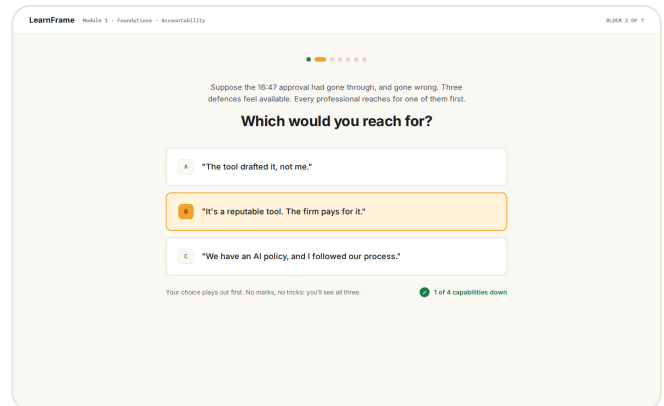

Industry eLearning completion rates are famously poor because most courses are content with a quiz attached. This programme is engineered differently. We call it the 16:47 approval, and it is the moment the programme stops being a course and becomes personal.

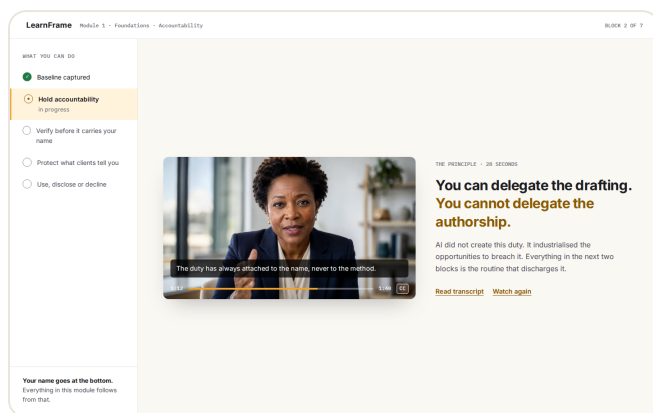

JUDGEMENT, NEVER RECALL

Every design decision serves completion: single-sitting modules with an honest time contract, progress displayed as capabilities gained rather than percentages, each block ending on a question the next block answers within five seconds, and assessment built on judgement under realistic conditions with consequence-based feedback. If a question can be answered by remembering a slide, it is cut.



SHORT VIDEO PRINCIPLE MOMENTS, CAPTIONED THROUGHOUT

TRANSPARENCY, BY DESIGN

Our presenters are AI-generated. Every word they deliver is human-verified. That is the entire point of this programme, and it meets the AI Act's transparency obligations for synthetic media as they arrive.

Volatile facts never appear in video, so the programme's quarterly re-verification is an editing task, not a reshoot. Accessibility is engineered in: WCAG 2.2 AA verified colour contrast, minimum target sizes, captions on all video, and every screen usable in silence.

Current on the day it is opened

AI guidance goes stale quickly, and stale compliance content is a liability with your name on it. Every module carries a visible verification stamp and is re-verified quarterly. The programme is deadline-independent by design: it stands on professional accountability, which survives every regulatory amendment, so nothing needs rewriting when the next omnibus lands.

Certificates of outcomes, not attendance
